Overall evaluation: 1 (weak accept)
The problem that is read in the background is about how the website is achieved by the solution of e-government concept to know how far its service can reach and Increase the public participation of Palembang. But what is then done is to test the extent to which transparency and trust can be used as a proposed model. There is a mismatch of written ideas between background, review and methodology and discussion
On the other hand the written abstract explains that this paper aims to investigate the factors of e- government based on transparency and trust in the provision of information and the use of services to people.
The writing is quite long up to 11 pages but most of it is in the form of basic theory. The review literature subsection does not reflect this research position among the previous similar research.

Overall evaluation: 1 (weak Accept)
<ol> <li>List Author(s) and affiliation(s) below title.</li> <li>English is very poor. There are numerous grammatical errors, runoff sentences, incomplete sentences, incongruent structures, typographical errors, etc. Some abbreviations were not explained.</li> <li>"Low Class Society" needs to be clearly defined.</li> <li>Introduction and literature review occupies one-half of the paper. Needs to be drastically reduced.</li> <li>Research method was not thoroughly explained.</li> <li>Resulting model was not thoroughly discussed.</li> <li>Results of implementation was not clear and was not thoroughly discussed.</li> <li>Need to consider level of technological penetration among subject matters.</li> <li>Availability of technological infrastructures to subject matters such as computers and internet connections were not described in the model.</li> <li>Table 3: total of Sent column should be 320 (not 200).</li> </ol>
