The Formula of Simple Past Tense

$$S + V2 + O/C$$

Positive

(+) S + V2+ Object + Complement

Negative

(–) S + did + not + Verb1 + Object + Complement

Interrogative

(?) Did + S + Verb1 + Object + Complement?

Example:

- (+) he <u>read</u> a newspaper every morning.
- () he did not <u>read</u> a newspaper every morning.
- (?) Did he <u>read</u> a newspaper every morning?
 - Yes, he did.
 - No, he did.
- (+) they <u>played</u> football every Sunday.
- () they did not play football every Sunday.
- (?) Did they play football every Sunday?
 - Yes, they did.
 - No, they did not.



Nominal Sentence

- Was → I, he, She, It, Singular noun
 - I was happy
- Were → You, They, We, Plural Nouns
 - The cars were beautiful
